RMD 9. **Geraldine Boller Memorial Arrangement Trophy**

This exhibit will be placed in the arrangement section of the show. The exhibit will be a traditional design (line, line-mass or mass) using fresh miniature roses and other fresh plant material, not to exceed 10 inches in height, width or depth. The exhibitor will provide the container. Please use an arrangement entry tag.

RMD 10. **The Dr. William A. Campbell Shrub Trophy** The exhibit will be three lateral bloom sprays, each a different variety, each exhibited in its own container and correctly named on a separate entry tag. Specimens may be selected from species roses, old garden roses, shrub roses, hybrid Wichuranas (ramblers) and large-flowered climbers. The specimens may not exceed 30 inches above the neck of the container.

Photography rules:

- Entries are limited to one photograph per class per exhibitor.
- Previously exhibited photographs will not be accepted.
- Photographs must have been taken within the last two years.
- All photographs are to be mounted and matted.
- The maximum size of the photograph is 8x10 inches, excluding the mat.
- The roses in the photograph should be named on the entry tag if possible, although this will not affect the judging.
- Photographs may be in black and white or color.
- Correct sub-class placement is the responsibility of the exhibitor. Photos will be judged in the class in which they are placed.
- Blue ribbons will be given to the best photographs in each class: second, third and honorable mention ribbons may also be awarded.
- The Kirkley Award will go to the best of the four blue ribbons.
- The name of the exhibitor must not appear on the face of the photograph or on its mat. Presence of a name will cause the entry to be disqualified.

RMD-II(a). One rose bloom (not a bud) as the subject.

RMD-II(b). One rose spray (two or more blooms) as the subject.

RMD-II(c). A rose garden or an in-ground group of roses as a subject.

RMD-II(d). A abstracted rose or roses in whole or part as the subject.
