The Pikes Peak Rose Society, in Colorado Springs, Colorado, invites you to the Annual Rocky Mountain District Show and Awards Dinner on June 25, 2016. We will be Celebrating the 20<sup>th</sup> Year of the Pikes Peak Rose Society.

## Accommodations



For our out-of-town friends, a special room rate of **\$94** per night for a double queen or king room has been arranged at the Clarion Hotel, at Exit 142 off I-25 in downtown Colorado Springs for Friday and Saturday nights. Rooms can be reserved by calling the hotel directly at **719-471-8680** and ask for the **Rose Society Group Block**. You must call the hotel direct to receive this rate.

If you are staying only Saturday night, their sister hotel, the Quality Inn & Suites, which is located adjacent to the Clarion, is offering a two-room suite featuring two queen beds, a hide-a-bed in the living room, and TWO bathrooms at the special room rate of **\$109** per night. Rooms can be reserved by calling the hotel directly at **719-471-8681** and ask for the **Rose Society Group Block**. Note that at this time there are no rooms at the Quality Inn for Friday, June 24<sup>th</sup>. You must call the hotel direct to receive this rate.



Both the Clarion and Quality Inn include a free breakfast for each registered guest. Free wifi is also available at both facilities. There is an indoor pool and hot tub and a large outdoor courtyard available to enjoy those refreshing Colorado evenings. There will be shuttle service from the Clarion and Quality Inn to the Awards Dinner. You can enjoy dinner, have a glass or two of libation and return safely to

your hotel without having to drive.

The cutoff date for making reservations is June 10, 2016. Please note that reservations received after the above cut-off date may be subject to prevailing rates at that time. Rooms may be cancelled by June 23<sup>rd</sup> without charge. Make your reservations early as there are a limited number of rooms available at this rate.

### Directions:

From I-25 traveling South, take exit 142 – Bijou (Downtown)  
At the top of the ramp at the light turn right (West)  
The hotel is immediately on your right.

From I-25 traveling North, take exit 142 – Bijou (Downtown)  
At the top of the ramp at the light, turn left (West) and get in left lane  
Go over the bridge and the hotel is just past the southbound exit ramp.

## Rose Show

Directions to the show:

Take I-25 (from North or South) to exit 160, Academy Blvd Exit.  
Go South on Academy Blvd (North takes you into the Air Force Academy)  
At the second stoplight (Jamboree) turn left (Northeast)  
The third (3<sup>rd</sup>) street is Chapel Hills Drive  
The library is on the NW corner of this intersection  
Turn left on Chapel Hills Drive  
Turn left at the second driveway to enter the upper parking lot  
Judges should use the main entrance  
Exhibitors will use the door to the North of the main entrance

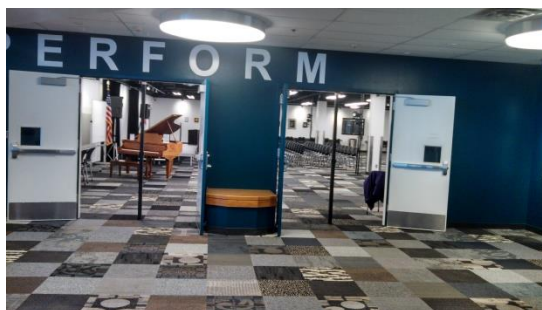
**Exhibitors – please remove all of your entries at 4 p.m. sharp.** Exhibits left on the tables at 4:15 p.m. will be removed by the clean-up committee.

## Awards Dinner



The Rocky Mountain District Awards Dinner and Annual Meeting will be held at the famed Patty Jewett Golf Course, one of the oldest golf courses west of the Mississippi. Directions to the golf course:

From I-25 (North or South Bound)  
Take Exit 143 – Uintah Street  
Go East (away from the mountains) on Uintah to Nevada Avenue – 2<sup>nd</sup> Stoplight  
Turn right (North) on Nevada Avenue  
Travel five (5) blocks to Espanola Street  
Turn right (East – away from the mountains) on Espanola Street  
Travel six (6) blocks east to the entrance to the golf course  
Enter the golf course and drive through to the parking area  
Enter on the south side of the Clubhouse  
We will dine in the large room on the right (past the hallway on the right)



## Special Guest

Pat Shanley, President of the American Rose Society, will be our special guest for the show and the awards dinner.



Pat Shanley lives and gardens in Glen Cove, NY, where she grows approximately 250 roses. She is also an ARS Horticultural Judge; ARS Arrangement Judge; ARS Master Rosarian; Recipient of the ARS New York District Silver Honor Medal, Outstanding Judge and Outstanding Consulting Rosarian Awards; Recipient ARS Bronze Medal; Founding and Immediate Past President of the Manhattan Rose Society; Founding Chairman of the New York Metropolitan Rose Council; Chairman of the Great Rosarians of the World™ East

(GROW™) Award Lectureship; Past Vice Chairman, Queens Botanical Garden Board of Trustees and Chairman of American Garden Rose Selections™ - the new national testing program for new rose varieties. Pat was the Guest Editor of the 2012 ARS Annual. She is also the co-editor and a contributing author of "The Sustainable Rose Garden - A Reader in Rose Culture" 2010, published by Newbury books, (an imprint of Casemate Publishers) which received the World Federation of Rose Societies Literary Award for 2012.

The title of her program will be " A Vision of Roses...A Vision of ARS." It will address the new testing program, American Garden Rose Selections, ARS and what we hope to accomplish.
